We offer Associate Membership to members of the UK Conservative Party, as well as organising speaker meetings, debates, fund-raising events and fringe meetings at UK Conservative Party conferences.

Collection and Use of Personal Information

When you visit and navigate our website, and when you communicate with us via our website, we will not collect personal information about you unless you provide us with that information voluntarily.

Any information that you do register with us will be stored securely and will only be used to deliver the service requested by you. Such information is stored securely in password encrypted files and is accessible only by a member of our Executive committee, details of which can be found on our website.

When you visit our website, our web server automatically recognises no information regarding your domain name, IP or e-mail address. We do not currently use "cookies".

We collect the e-mail addresses of those who communicate with us via e-mail, information volunteered by consumers (such as survey information) and/or site registrations, as well as name and address, telephone numbers, fax number and payment information (e.g. credit/debit card or other banking details and billing address) where voluntarily provided.

The information we collect is used to improve the content of our website, the quality of our service to Associate Members and/or consumers, as well as to contact Associate Members and/or consumers for marketing purposes.

If you supply us with your postal address online or otherwise, you may receive periodic mailings from us with information on new products and services or upcoming events. If you do not wish to receive such mailings, please let us know by contacting us as outlined above.

If you supply us with your telephone numbers online or otherwise, you may receive telephone contact from us with information regarding new products and services or upcoming events. If you do not wish to receive such telephone calls, please let us know by contacting us as outlined above.

We do not share any of our information with any other organisations.

Changes in Information Practices

If our information practices change at some point in the future, we will post such policy changes in a revised statement on our website to notify you of these changes and provide you with the ability to opt out of any new uses. If you are concerned about how your information is used, you should check this statement on our website periodically.

Customers may prevent their information from being used for purposes other than those for which it was originally collected by e-mailing us at the above address, calling us at the above telephone number or writing to us at the above address.

Upon request we will provide site visitors with access to all information [including proprietary information] that we maintain about them. Associate Members and/or consumers can access this information by e-mailing us at the above address, calling us at the above telephone number or writing to us at the above address.

Accuracy of Personal Information

If you feel that any information that we hold relating to you is incorrect, you can contact us to amend it by e-mailing us at the above address, calling us at the above telephone number or writing to us at the above address. We aim to respond to all queries within 5 working days.

Refund, Cancellation and Returns Policies

Associate Membership subscriptions (all methods of payment)

All Associate Membership subscriptions are non-refundable once collected, unless you have notified us in writing to cancel your Associate Membership at least 10 working days prior to the date the payment becomes due for collection (this date will be the anniversary of the payment date in the previous year for both credit/debit card and Standing Order payments).

Please note that we can only cancel a recurring credit/debit card payment. We cannot cancel a Standing Order from you to Conservative Way Forward. You must contact your bank to ask them to cancel a Standing Order. Please also notify us in writing.

Associate Membership

When you join Conservative Way Forward, you can expect a welcome letter within 28 days. You will also receive copies of all of our publications (including Forward magazine, any fast Forward newsletters, any policy papers or any other one-off publications) periodically. You will usually receive at least two issues of Forward magazine per annum.

All other purchases

Where you have not provided an email address, we will post a receipt for your payment along with hard copy ticket(s) and further information regarding your purchase and the event.
